1.3 Planning, Budgeting and Monitoring System (PBMS)

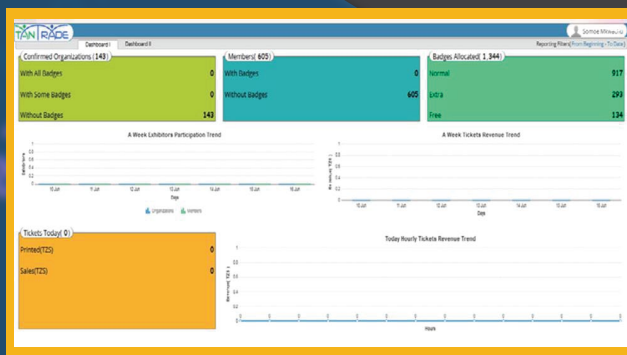

1.5 Integrated Financial Management Information System (IFMIS)

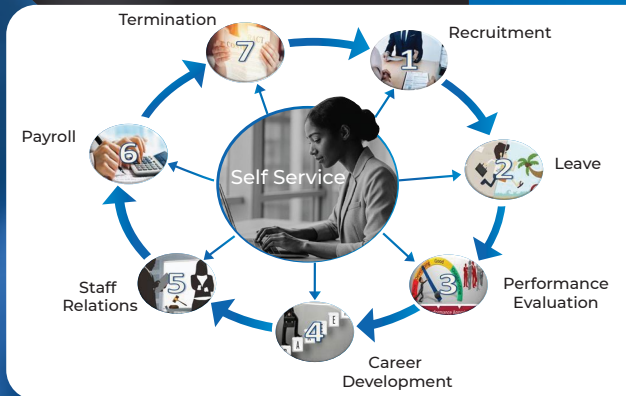

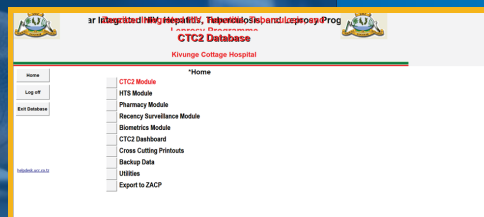
1.6 Human Resource Management Information System (HRMIS)

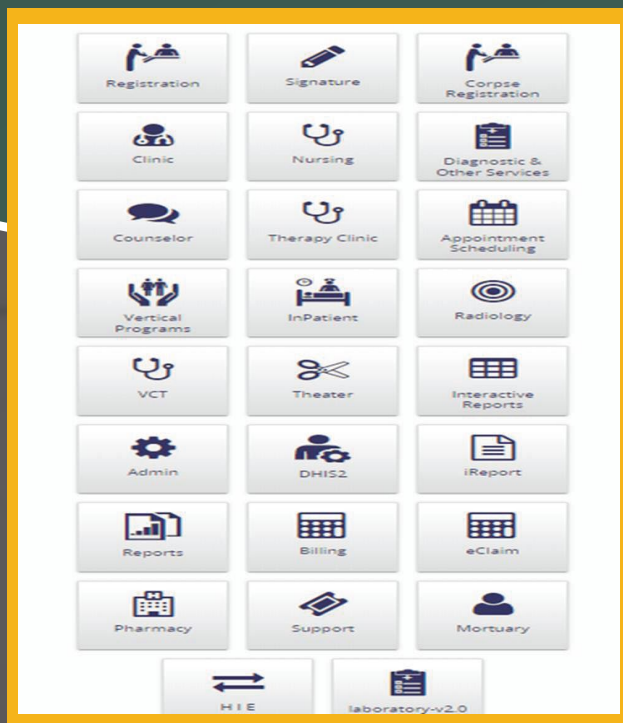
1.7 Care and Treatment Clinic (CTC 2 & 3)

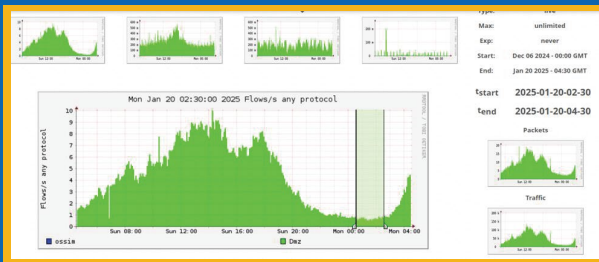
